## **Senator Hanig Appointed to Environmental, Emergency Management, and Public Safety Interim Committees**

**Raleigh, N.C.** – Senate Leader Phil Berger (R-Rockingham) announced today that he appointed Sen. Bobby Hanig (R-Currituck) to three committees for the 2023-24 legislative interim.

Sen. Hanig will serve on the following committees during the interim:

- Environmental Review Commission
- Joint Legislative Oversight Committee on Emergency Management
- Joint Legislative Oversight Committee on Justice and Public Safety

The lion's share of legislative work happens during committee meetings at the General Assembly. Interim committees allow legislators to take a more in-depth look at issues facing the state. The

work that is done during the interim impacts the legislation senators pursue during the 2024 short session, which is set to begin in late April.
